It is easy to talk about photography and making quality images but quite another to do so. Let's think for a moment about creativity in the world of photography. The first step is to visualize. Sometimes this is the most difficult part. If you have an idea, jot it down. At your local camera club or at ACCC, allow yourself to be filled with ideas. I like to attend salon judgments just to see the images that are unsuccessful! (This can be done at ACCC as well.) This takes us to the next step in the creative process, making the actual image. This is as vital as the idea. One must know how to use one's camera. Constant practice is absolutely paramount. I not

infrequently see the vacation pictures of people who bought a fine camera but never practiced. One can but imagine the scenario! After the images are captured comes another critical bridge, selecting the truly quality, impactful image. Here the camera club and club council can help. Here one can get a measure of how well the imaging process has been mastered. Request critique--- good and bad. Ask someone in whom you have confidence and in whom you like their style to give you insight into one of your works. Change or redo your picture. Let your images go from acceptance to honored up to prize-winner. KEEP THOSE SHUTTERS CLICKING.

"VIRGIN" SLIDE COMPETITION

In this competition each slide entered must be "as shot" and must be shot originally on slide film and not modified in any manner after the picture is taken other than cropping the slide in some manner such as using a Gepe mount. It is permissible to have filters on the camera when the shot is taken.

This category is being started to allow competition within ACCC in a category that does not include the manipulation we are experiencing in most other competitions and categories. We hope you seriously consider competing in this new (or is it old) category. If you purchased a new digital SLR that uses your old lenses, you just might want to start carrying your old film body to be ready to take slides for this competition.

COMPETITION RULES SPRING ROUNDUP 2006

Print Competition

Please note that the Print Competition rules established before the 2005 Fall Roundup are still in effect for the 2006 Spring Roundup. #1: The maximum number of entries in any one competition category is now limited to two (2) prints, reduced from three (3) entries previously. #2: There will be no distinction between "color Commercial" and "color by maker". Likewise, there will be no distinction between "monochromatic commercial" and "monochromatic by maker". #2 applies to Open, Nature and Rotating Category.

Thus:	Prints allowed
1. Open	
monochromatic	2
color	2
2. Nature	
monochromatic	2
color	2
3. Rotating (can be color or monochromatic and can be commercial or by maker)	2

Prints may be of any size but must be securely mounted on a board no smaller than 11 X 14 and no larger than 16 X 20. Prints may be matted but must not be framed or glassed.

A completed ACCC Print Entry Label (provided by ACCC) must be affixed to the upper left area on the back of each mounted print. Each camera club must submit a completed ACCC Competition Entry Form (provided by ACCC) listing each entry submitted by its club members. Entry fee is \$1.00 per print. Entries with entry fees are to be turned in to the Print Competition Chairman not later than the ACCC Board Meeting approximately one month prior to the Spring Roundup and the Fall Roundup.

Slide Competition

Individuals can enter up to two slides in each of four categories; Open, Nature, Rotating or Virgin

Thus	Slides allowed
1. Open	2
2. Nature	2
3. Rotating	2
4. Virgin	2

Please spot your slide correctly for viewing: Hold the slide so you are viewing it right side up. Place the spot on the Lower Left Corner. Any slides that are not spotted get the committee's best guess as to which way is up. Slides that are spotted incorrectly may be seen sideways or even upside down if they are not caught. Entry fee is \$1.00 per slide.

Digital Competition

Individuals can enter up to two entries in each of four categories, Open, Nature, Rotating and Creative Expression.

Thus:	images allowed
1. Open	2
2. Nature	2
3. Rotating	2
4. Creative Expression	2

All entries are to be submitted through the club representative at the ACCC Fall Board Meeting. Email entries are no longer being accepted. Clubs should submit entries via CD along with standard ACCC Club Entry Forms with accompanying payment for each entry.

All entries are to be sized to a maximum of 1024 pixels wide and 768 pixels high. The projector can only handle this maximum size without resizing the image. All entries are to be JPEG with the maximum quality level, typically 10 or 12 (lowest possible compression)

Naming convention is simplified from Spring 2005 when email entries were acceptable. Please still insure the category, maker and title of the image is contained in the file name to prevent confusion.

Examples of file names include:

- O, Doe, John, Urban Landscape
 - N, Doe, Jane, Grand Tetons at Sunset
 - R, Smith, Jane, Hopi Dancers in Costume
 - C, Smith, John, Boat with Colored Pencil Filter
- Legend: O: Open, N: Nature, R: Rotating, and C: Creative Expression

Entry fee is \$1.00 per digital image.
