ACCC HONORS AWARDS

ACCC presents Honors Awards yearly at the Fall Roundup in recognition of service, achievements and contributions to the art of amateur photography through a persons activities in the Arizona Camera Club Council. The Honors Committee is seeking nominees for consideration for the Fall 2012 Roundup. There are three types of awards: **Associateship**, **Fellowship** and **Honorary Fellowship**. The **Associateship** is restricted to members of ACCC affiliated clubs and may be awarded for outstanding service to ACCC. It requires a favorable vote by five of the six members of the Honors Committee.

The **Fellowship** may be awarded to a member of an affiliated ACCC club for outstanding service to ACCC after said member has held the **Associateship** for two years. This award requires a reasonable degree of individual achievement in the art of photography and receive a favorable vote by five committee members. The **Honorary Fellowship** is awarded for **most** outstanding service to ACCC and to amateur photography as a whole. The recipient may be a member of an affiliated club but does not need to be. This requires a unanimous vote by the Honors Committee.

The Honors Committee is requesting nominations for these awards from our membership. Do you have someone who deserves recognition. ACCC COMPETITION RULES

ACCC Has Updated Competition Rules

To celebrate the new competition year, ACCC has made some changes to the Competition Rules for both the Print and Projected Images Divisions.

Like many other organizations, ACCC has increased the maximum dimensions for digital images from the old 1024 x 768 pixels to a new standard: 1400 x 1050 pixels. Images may still be entered at the smaller size, but you will want to migrate to the new size to get the most "impact" when your images are projected.

The biggest change in the Projected Images Division is that Nancy Sams has instituted an online process for entering digital images. Please visit the ACCC web site to read the details about the new entry process.

Changes in the Print Division rules are mainly in the area of mounting prints. We've had issues with mounting boards that are too thick, so the new rules clarify the acceptable mounting board dimensions. Here is a summary:

All prints must be mounted on a 16" x 20" board 1/16 – 1/8" thick (e.g. 4-ply mat board) If over-matting is used, only a single 4-ply over-mat may be used. To avoid damage to the print (or other prints that get stacked together), the rules have been clarified that prints and labels must be securely attached to the board. Labels should be positioned near the upper left-hand corner. When you print your labels for the back of your prints, please be sure to use the form provided on the ACCC web site.

Aside from these changes, some wording changes were also made to improve readability and clarity. Please take a look at the updated Competition Rules on the ACCC web site as you prepare for the 2012 Spring Roundup. If you have any questions, feel free to email the Competition Chairmen and me, and we'll be happy to help.



TIPS & HINTS: FODER'S TRAVEL INTELLIGENCE

In addition to offering you the marvelous convenience of being able to change focal lengths quickly between pictures, zoom lenses enable you to create a novel special effect by changing focal lengths during an exposure. The result of this zoom effect is a relatively sharp central subject engulfed in a radiant burst of light streaks. The effect works best with a strong color or tonal contrast or with a brightly colored subject set against a dark background. With your ISO set to a relatively slow speed (ISO 100 or 200), take a meter reading of your subject with your camera's exposure mode set to either shutter-priority or manual mode. The effect is most pronounced when you zoom through the entire focal range, so choose a relatively slow shutter speed—preferably 1/8 second or longer. To make the exposure, simply press the shutter button with one hand and slide or twist the zoom through its focal range with the other. Coordinating your two hands on the two controls takes some practice, but the slower the

PRINT COMPETITION

As discussed elsewhere in this edition of The Chronicle, the process for entering the spring 2012 ACCC digital competition is changing to provide direct individual, on-line submission of images, titles and payment. However, submission to print competition will continue to follow the same method we used last fall. Namely, print images and payment will be collected manually and the club representative will present the Excel spreadsheet, payment and prints to the Competition Chair at the ACCC board meeting scheduled for February 11, 2012. The Competition Chair will monitor the digital submission process and determine whether a modification of that process may be suitable for print submission at some future date.

Please check the ACCC rules under the "Competition" tab of the web page < <http://www.arizonacameraclubcouncil.org/> > to ensure the prints you submit to the spring competition adhere to the updated mounting and labeling requirements, which have been modified to enhance our ability to efficiently organize, judge and display your submissions without damage to them.

shutter speed, the more time you have to unravel the logistics.

Using a tripod is essential, because you're going to need both hands to operate camera controls and because once you begin the exposure, the reflex mirror of your DSLR will be locked up, blocking your view of the subject. It's also simpler to compose the picture if you zoom from the longest focal-length setting (telephoto) to the widest (wide-angle); that way you know for sure what will be in the center of your frame.

Once you are comfortable working with stationary objects in broad daylight, try something a little more challenging, like a sports-action shot. The added dynamics of the zoom streaks intensify the impression of speed and motion. Night shots are also powerful—as you zoom, each little droplet of light becomes a scintillating trail of color.



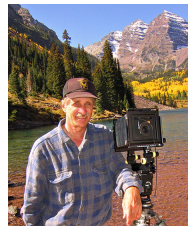

Chuck Lawsen is a freelance scenic and travel photographer specializing in large format images of Arizona and the Southwest. From classic scenes to innovative compositions, his images capture the beauty and essence of the land. Chuck enjoys producing images that make a strong visual impact that not only evoke an appreciation of nature, but hopefully also create an awareness of the importance to preserve our land and its resources.

He studied under Willis Peterson, the head of the photo department at Glendale Community College, whose work had been featured in Arizona Highways for many years. 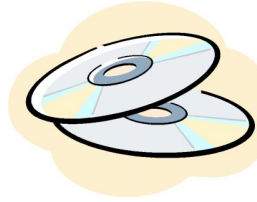

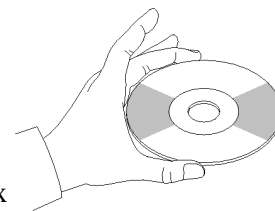
