## **ACCC PRINT COMPETITION**

### **Herman Dirks, Print Chairman**

Because the print competition utilizes a computer generated spreadsheet to organize the images for judging, and because the method of recording the scores at the judging is also based on a computer program using these spreadsheets, it is very important that all persons entering the competition use the latest print identification labels. These labels should be placed on the upper left corner on the back of the print mount. The labels are available from your club representative or may be downloaded from the ACCC web site.

It is also very important that every club representative accurately record all of the image information on their spreadsheet copies. These copies are to be submitted to the ACCC Treasurer. The print categories are:

A. Monochromatic (may not include more than one (1) color)

1. Nature and
2. Open

B. Color

1. Nature,
2. Open,
3. Creative and
4. Rotating.

Each person may only enter two (2) prints in any of the above categories, but the total number of prints that can be entered may not exceed six (6).

Prints must be mounted on a matt board that is not smaller than 11" x 14" or larger than 16" x 20."

What's in a digital image's name? I really don't know - do you? Judges do not see the name of the image nor will most persons viewing the results of a contest. What it does is create a problem for the person(s) who try to give credit for the work in creating a slides how. For the last Roundup there were 543 images submitted. The average words used in naming was approx. 4.5. Multiply the two together and you will see that over 2400 words had to be typed based upon how the show was put together. There will be modifications now and in the future to limit the number of titled images

Hopefully, someone in the audience will see the image and ask you to tell them more about it. That's your opportunity to not only tell the person where it was but also about the work you put into making the image.

**Strictly Automotive**

The Rotating Category for the Fall Round Up 2009 is "Strictly Automotive". This category includes images of all or any part of motorized vehicles intended for road use. Roads can be highways, dirt or undeveloped trails. Semis, commercial vehicles, buses, motorcycles, dune buggies, ATV, junk cars etc. or any parts of the vehicles can be included. Examples of vehicles that are not included would include boats, airplanes, helicopters or any vehicle that normally is not motorized. Creative interpretations of your images are acceptable.



**Faces and/or Hands**



"Faces and/or Hands" must include at least one (or more) human face(s) and/or human hand(s) as a center of interest in the image. The image must not be taken in a studio setup. Creative interpretations are acceptable in this category."

Future rotating categories include: Fall 2010, Humor (with title announced); Spring 2011, Photo Travel; Fall 2011, Old Building. Definitions for these categories will be provided at a later date for inclusion in future Chronicles.

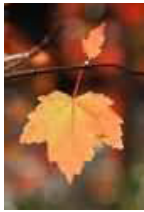
**REMINDER - ACCC HAS A

Assuming you are really going to elect me as President for the next couple of years, I would like to ask you for some help. I have been thinking that we really should start doing some new things in ACCC. I was particularly concerned when I heard that some members of one of our clubs felt that ACCC did not do much for them. I started thinking about the comment and the fact that in some clubs there are a lot of members that do not compete. Certainly we are about more than competition, but perhaps some club members don't see it that way.

Whatever the reason, I would like each club to spend some time considering the question: What would our club like to see from ACCC that is not happening now?

I will be attending the PSA Conference in West Yellowstone and intend to use a significant amount of the time trying to learn what is going on in other Councils. What I really would like to hear however is what do the Arizona clubs think ACCC can do: *to promote the mutual enjoyment of photography, to encourage advancement of its members in the knowledge and contributions to the progress of photography, to render service to its Member Clubs for the purpose of promoting the enjoyment of photography through membership in local camera clubs, to provide a means of exchange of ideas and ready communication through its various clubs, and to further the programs and activities of the Photographic Society of America.* These are of course words from our Constitution. This is what we are all about.

One idea that I am thinking about would be to form some sort of panel that could review images for members and comment on the quality of the image and how to make it better. Perhaps we could have people email images to some person who would send them to panel members who would comment on the image without seeing the comments of the other panel members. The objective is to get their thoughts not influenced by the other panel members. This could work a bit like the PSA Group concept. The intent would be to provide feedback, encouragement, and education without the members having to be involved with the competition process.

This is just one idea; perhaps some of you from member clubs can come in with some others ideas or provide some help in how to implement the above idea.

I look forward to your input at the Fall Board Meeting on Saturday, October 24th.

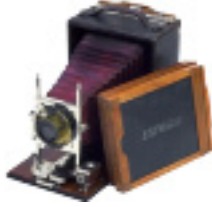
