COMPETITION RULE CHANGES FALL ROUNDUP 2005

General:

Cost: Submit \$1 per image for print, slide, or digital image divisions.

Open: Any image of any subject with any amount of modification the individual desires is acceptable.

Definition of Nature: Definition is based on the PSANatureDivision definition. *“Nature photography is restricted to the use of the photographic process to depict observations from all branches of natural history, except Anthropology and Archeology, in such a fashion that a well informed person will be able to identify the subject material and to certify as to its honest presentation. The story-telling value of a photograph must be weighed more than the pictorial quality. Human elements shall not be present, except on the rare occasion where those human elements enhance the nature story. The presence of scientific bands on wild animals is acceptable. Photographs of artificially produced hybrid plants or animals, mounted specimens, or obviously set arrangements, are ineligible, as is any form of manipulation that alters the truth of the photographic statement.”*

General processing such as levels, saturation, the usual sharpening along with cropping is acceptable. The integrity of the image must be maintained and show no “hand of man” other than stated in the nature definition above. To modify the scene

to remove the hand of man using processes such as cloning the contents of the image is not acceptable. Photos of zoo animals are acceptable if the zoo setting duplicates a natural setting with no man made objects such as feeding dishes in the scene.

Rotating Category, Fall Roundup: Native American Culture, Past & Present. The primary theme of the image is to be related to native culture (scenes, activities, costume, art, etc) from any part of the Americas in any time period. (go to page 3) 2

COMPETITION RULE CHANGES FALL ROUNDUP 2005 (Cont'd)

Creative Expression: This category is for Digital Image Competition only. All elements of a Creative Expression entry must be derived from photographic images of the maker. The maker must through his/her own efforts accomplish obvious creative modifications of the original photo or photos.

An image that wins an Honorable Mention or above can not be entered again in the same division (Print, Slide, or Digital) and the same category (Open, Nature, Rotating, Creative Expression). It can be entered again in ACCC competition, but either the division or category must be different. Entries that receive Acceptances may be submitted again with no restrictions.

Print Competition

Please note that there have been some changes in the Print Competition rules. These changes are effective immediately and will apply to the 2005 Fall Roundup. Change #1: The maximum number of entries in any one competition category is now limited to two (2) prints, reduced from three (3) entries previously. Change #2: There will be no distinction between "color Commercial" and "color by maker". Likewise, there will be no distinction between "monochromatic commercial" and "monochromatic by maker". Change #2 applies to Open, Nature and Rotating Category.

3. Rotating (can be color or monochromatic and can be commercial or by maker)	2

Prints may be of any size but must be securely mounted on a board no smaller than 11 X 14 and no larger than 16 X 20. Prints may be matted but must not be framed or glassed.

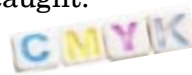
A completed ACCC Print Entry Label (provided by ACCC) must be affixed to the upper left area on the back of each mounted print. Each camera club must submit a completed ACCC Competition Entry Form (provided by ACCC) listing each entry submitted by its club members. Entries with entry fees are to be turned in to the Print Competition Chairman not

later than the ACCC Board Meeting approximately one month prior to the Spring Roundup and the Fall Roundup.

A report from the committee regarding the handling of points when the "commercial" and "made by maker" print categories are combined recommended that the points from the two categories be combined and awards be made accordingly based on the combined totals. Everyone in attendance agreed.

Slide Competition

Individuals can enter up to two slides in each of three categories, Open, Nature or Rotating. Please spot your slide correctly for viewing: Hold the slide so you are viewing it right side up. Place the spot on the Lower Left Corner. Any slides that are not spotted get the committee's best guess as to which way is up. Slides that are spotted incorrectly may be seen sideways or even upside down if they are not caught.



Digital Competition

Individuals can enter up to two entries in each of four categories, Open, Nature, Rotating and Creative Expression. All entries are to be submitted through the club representative at the ACCC Fall Board Meeting. Email entries are no longer being accepted. Clubs should submit entries via CD along with standard ACCC Club Entry Forms with accompanying payment for each entry.

All entries are to be sized to a maximum of 1024 pixels wide and 768 pixels high. The projector can only handle this maximum size without resizing the image. All entries are to be JPEG with the maximum quality level, typically 10 or 12 (lowest possible compression)

Naming convention is simplified from Spring 2005 when email entries were acceptable. Please still insure the category, maker and title of the image is contained in the file name to prevent confusion. Examples of file names include:

O, Doe, John, Urban Landscape

N, Doe, Jane, Grand Tetons at Sunset

R, Smith, Jane, Hopi Dancers in Costume

C, Smith, John, Boat with Colored Pencil Filter

Where: O: Open, N: Nature, R: Rotating, and C: Creative Expression

ABOUT OUR CLUB - ----- **SUN LAKES CAMERA CLUB**

The Sun Lakes Camera Club held its first meeting on February 6, 1980 in response to an ad placed in the Sun Lakes news paper by Doug and Elma Ireton.

16 interested Sun Lakers met in the club house to organize the club and it has been going strong ever since. Three of the original members have been awarded life memberships although they are unable to attend our meetings. One of the original members, Emma Alexander, is still actively involved in the club activities as well as competing in ACCC.

The club currently meets on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month from October through April each year. Membership is open to any resident or home owner in the Sun Lakes Community.

Photo essays, travelettes, and work shops are presented at the first meeting of the month and competitions in both slides and prints are held on the second meeting.

In addition to regular meetings, programs are presented for the general public on selected Sunday evenings during January, February and March.

The club has been an active member of ACCC for many years and are looking forward to continued involvement in the competitions.

SAGUARO CAMERA CLUB

The Saguaro Camera Club is one of the best known PSA camera clubs in North America. It is not a large club with active membership at less than 50 photographers. It has a long history of exhibition excellence, service to PSA and photographic activity. It meets the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month year around at 5:30 for dinner followed by a carefully planned educational experience or energetic competition. Summer meetings are more casual and personal. Meetings are at Coco's Restaurant in Mesa at the corner of Baseline and Dobson Roads.

The club's monthly competition experience consists entirely of the projected image. The club contests both digital and transparency images. The club's new digital projector is carefully warmed and calibrated by the competition committee for each contest. Digital competition rules are essentially the same as for PSA-sanctioned international competition. There is a regular division and a master's division so as to allow a comprehensive experience. Excellent images abound. An awards ceremony follows. Members are encouraged to tap winning images for further competition usually starting with ACCC.

SAGUARO (cont'd)

A print preview for ACCC is held bi-annually to encourage a full membership participation. An awards ceremony is held and excellence is recognized. The club competes in a PSA invitational contest on a yearly basis as well as PSA Interclub Competition in Mono- and Color Prints, Nature Slides, Photo-Travel Slides and Pictorial Slides. All club entries are reviewed at time of award's recognition. The club is currently in second place by only a few points in its first year of mono- print competition. Class A Color Prints are doing very well, too. The club was first in PSA Interclub Pictorial Slides Competition last year. This was the club's first year in competition. The club's competition in Class A Nature Slides was in the top 7 out of several hundred participating clubs. In Class A Photo-Travel against similar odds the club is currently in first place.

The club is blessed with a number of highly active international exhibitors in many divisions. These members continue to serve as PSA officers, conference speakers, chairpersons and the like. These same members actively teach at ACCC and in the club. The bi-monthly dinners serve as a nidus for the dissemination of photographic moxie. Under the direction of the club's field trip chairperson, the club is constantly going on carefully planned outings. These allow all members to constantly add to their image files. The trips are followed by photo review sessions to aid each member in improving image quality. Local, state and international field trips are held.

The Saguaro Camera Club has formed two spin-off clubs. One of these clubs was formed several years ago to discuss practical aspects of digital photography and to hear digital lectures. The other club reviews digital prints and images and presents lectures related to digital printmaking. These two clubs hold no competitions of any type.
