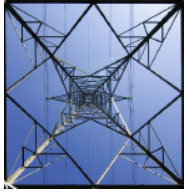
May you stay healthy, continue to do good work and we will see you on Saturday, April 25th, 2009 at our Spring Round Up.

ACCC Slide Competition Ending

The ACCC board approved a resolution to end slide competition. This is in recognition that the Digital Competition is getting most Projected Image attention from members. Few members are shooting slides in the camera and in Fall 2008 competition, only three people entered slides that did not enter digital. Total slides entered had dropped to 89 slides in four categories. It is clear that digital is meeting the needs of members and it is hard to have a meaningful competition with limited participation in slides.

It is sad to see the passing of what has been great competition within ACCC. The table decoration at the roundup with slides in a vase and an RIP sign on the table was perhaps symbolic of the fact that it was time to make this decision.

ACCC Digital Chair Change

Dik Salsbury of Grand Photos has been handling our digital competition for several roundups and assisted with the task virtually since the digital competition started. While Dik has been involved, digital entries have increased dramatically to 478 entries in Fall 2008 competition. Dik has prepared great ProShow presentations of digital results for a number of roundups prior to taking responsibility as the Digital Chairman. We owe Dik thanks for the professional job as Chairman and those great presentations. Dik has also been the Grand Photos Digital Chairman for several years.

John Frelich of Photography West is taking over responsibility for digital competition at ACCC beginning with the Spring 2009 Roundup. John is experienced with running digital competition at Photography West for several years. Thank you John for taking on this task for ACCC. This has grown to a major job within ACCC and you can be assured we all appreciate your taking over this position.

Essence of Arizona

The image must be taken within the state of Arizona. The image is to portray a scene or subject that would be considered typical of some well known aspect of the state. There are many possible examples, but the scene could focus on Arizona industry, scenery, plant or animal life, or the culture dress or lifestyle of a significant part of Arizona people such as American Indian, Hispanic, ranching, mining, agriculture etc. Creative interpretations of your images are acceptable.



Strictly Automotive

This category includes images of all or any part of motorized vehicles intended for road use. Roads can be highways, dirt or undeveloped trails. Semis, commercial vehicles, buses, motorcycles, dune buggies, ATV, junk cars etc. or any parts of the vehicles can be included. Examples of vehicles that are not included would include boats, airplanes, helicopters or any vehicle that normally is not motorized. Creative interpretations of your images are acceptable.

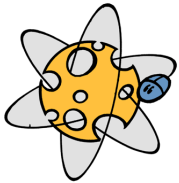

ALL ABOUT HONORS

First, what is an honor? An honor is a designation presented by a group to someone who has, through special effort, distinguished themselves in the eyes of the group. ACCC has three honors. They are Associate of the ACCC, Fellow of the ACCC and Honorary Fellow of the ACCC. Each successive title indicates more effort and thus greater honor. They are written after the holder's name in capital letters. An example is, Nancy Sams, FACCC. Honor's candidates are nominated by ACCC Club Delegate or ACCC Member Club Presidents. The criteria for these honors is amazingly simple. The criteria are as follows: 1) Service rendered to ACCC, 2) Services and activities in the member clubs, 3) Services to affiliated ACCC clubs and, finally, 4) Actual achievement in the Art of Photography. It is important for people giving service in these areas to keep some record to help should they be nominated. Selection is by the Honor's Committee which has been appointed by the president. The members are Stan Bormann, AACCC, Bill Dart, Dale Keiser, Gaither Randall, AACCC and Nancy Sams, FACCC. The Chairman of the Honors Committee is Lou Romain. SUMMARY OF 2008 COMPETITIONS

For the Fall Round Up, there were a total of 649 entries: 382 Prints, 89 Slides and 478 Digital. Our thanks go to Walter Ross, who served for three years as Print Competition Chairman. He will be replaced by the team of Lou Romain (monochrome prints) and Herman Dirks (color prints). Also, our thanks go to Dik Salisbury, Digital Competition Chairman, and Stan Bormann, Slide Competition Chairman, for their service. Dik will be replaced by John Frelich as the new Digital Competition Chairman. As very few people continue to shoot new slides, there will be no Slide competition next year.

Thirty eight people from eight clubs received 40 Star and 13 Galaxy certificates, including 18 people who received their *first (or better) Star certificate. For the first time in ACCC history, two people achieved 7 Galaxies (presently the highest): Edwin Flowers, Monochrome Prints; Lou Romain, Projected Images.
